#### **Supply List for Students:**

- 1. Fabric scraps: ½ yard of assorted light and dark
- 2. 2 or 3 items to paint: a top, tote bags, or whatever else you'd like to work with.

- 4. An apron if you don't want paint on your clothes.
- 5. An assortment of embroidery threads, needles, and a hoop if you want to embellish your project.
