The 2021 Challenge is “Flying Free.” No specific style nor size is required, each entry can include: Inspiration can come from anywhere or anything. Members are challenged to apply the Challenge rules to stitch and/or quilt their own interpretation in fabric in one, two or three dimensions. Quilts to be exhibited include traditional, modern & art quilts, clothing, and a variety of styles & techniques. The show is not juried nor judged, so it encourages creativity at all levels. It is always a great thrill to see someone new to quilting/art quilts show their work alongside long-time quilters.

2021 Challenge Rules:

There is no size, fabric, color, or design limitations for an exhibit quilt. We are “Flying Free” this Challenge year.

We would like everyone that made a quilt for the 2020 “cancelled” Challenge to plan to enter it in the 2021 Challenge Show.

For those that would like to have more than one entry, we are also celebrating our 25th Anniversary!

Below are the Challenge guidelines for 2021:

1. Make a quilt of your own design and/or pattern/color choice.
2. Enter the quilt(s) you made for the 2020 “A Star is Born” – not required but welcomed.
3. Add a little silver to your 2020 entry to celebrate our 25th Anniversary if you like – not required.
4. No maximum or minimum sizes.
5. Fabrics & piecing techniques are of the designer’s choice.

In summary, you can enter your 2020 Challenge quilt as your only entry or make one for 2021 or do both. The silver is a suggestion and not a requirement. Please keep in mind that the quilt cannot be more than 2 years old and cannot have been shown in a previous show.

6. Registration fee is \$20.00 per entry if the item is not for sale. Makes checks payable to Gualala Arts and include with your entry/registration form. While there is no limit on number of entries, please indicate your order of preference if hanging space becomes a problem.
7. Please fill out an Entry Form for EACH piece. Turn in the top portion to Gualala Arts, with entry fee, if applicable by the deadline. When delivering the art, attach the Entry Label portion securely to EACH piece.
8. This show is NOT juried and is open only to PPQG members in good standing. The work submitted should be no more than 2 years old and may not have been exhibited publicly on the Mendonoma coast at any time in the past.
9. Gualala Arts will retain 30% commission on all sales of entries (and multiples) made during the exhibit.
10. The curator will provide a binder to display an “Artist Statement” for each artist. Please submit the Artist Statement with your Entry Form.
11. Prepare your quilt for hanging: Each quilt entry should have a 4” hanging sleeve and a dowel or slate that measures 1” less than the width of the quilt. Artist name and quilt title should be on the dowel or slat. Mini quilts may have a 2” hanging sleeve with a dowl measuring 1” less than the width of the quilt. A sleeve is not required for postcard size quilts.
12. All quilts, except postcards, must have a label stating the quilt title, name of artist, date and location stitched onto the quilt back in the lower right corner.
13. Gualala Arts is not liable for any artwork or installation, at any point in the process.
14. Quilts must be picked up between 10:00 AM & 2:00 PM - Monday November 8, 2021. There will be a \$5 per day fee charged by GAC for those remaining after November 8, 2021.
